NEWS & NOTES:

FOR STARTERS:

Roosevelt has a pair of critical home conference contests on the slate this week with a tilt versus IU South Bend on Wednesday before St. Francis (Ill.) invades Attack Athletics on Saturday afternoon. The Lakers (0-1), Titans (0-1) and Saints (0-2) are all winless in league play this season. Roosevelt has not dropped back-to-back home games this year and is on the heels of a heartbreaking 66-64 loss to Judson at Attack Athletics on Saturday. Overall, the Lakers are 6-3 in their home facility this season. Either Paul or Mark Tometich has led Roosevelt in scoring in each of the last nine games.

WONDER TWINS ACTIVATE:

Twin brothers Mark and Paul Tometich have provided a potent one-two punch of late for Roosevelt with the senior duo combining to average 31.6 points, 7.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists in the last three games. Paul Tometich posted 22 points and six rebounds in a win over Trinity Interna-

tional on Jan. 16, while Mark Tometich tallied a season-high 19 points two days later at Holy Cross before scoring 17 points on Jan. 21 versus Judson. Paul Tometich also tied his career high with seven assists versus the Eagles, while also tabbing 12 points and five boards.

SCOUTING IU SOUTH BEND:

Indiana University South Bend enters Wednesday night's contest with an even season ledger of 10-10 and 0-1 record in league play. The Titans have dropped four of their last five games, including a 71-69 setback in their last outing versus Holy Cross on Jan. 21. Henry Smith led IUSB with 20 points versus the Saints. Much like Roosevelt, the Titans are paced by a brother duo in 6-foot-3 guards Kyle and Steven Heatherly. Kyle Heatherly leads the team in scoring at 14.7 ppg, while adding 3.6 rpg. Steven Heatherly totals 11.5 ppg and 3.5 rpg.

ROOSEVELT vs. SOUTH BEND, THE SERIES:

The Lakers are 0-2 all-time versus IU South Bend, losing both decisions in last year's home-and-home conference series. Roosevelt fell at IUSB on Jan. 26, 59-51 and then lost to the Titans at home on Feb. 16, 57-39. Twin brothers Mark and Paul Tometich have both enjoyed success versus IUSB with Mark Tometich averaging 17.5 points and Paul Tometich 16.0 points in the team's two meetings.

SCOUTING ST. FRANCIS (III.):

The Saints enter Saturday's contest sitting at 0-2 in the CCAC after an 87-68 loss at #2 Robert Morris on Jan. 24. The setback snapped a three-game winning streak for St. Francis (Ill.), which had recently swept a trio of CCAC crossover games versus Holy Cross, Judson and Purdue North Central. The Saints are led this season by a pair of 6-foot-4 seniors, Jordan Lee and Lukas Zebrauskas. Lee averages 14.9 ppg and 6.2 rpg, while Zebrauskas tallies 11.4 ppg and 6.2 rpg for second-year head coach John Baines.

ROOSEVELT vs. ST. FRANCIS (III.), THE SERIES:

The Lakers are 0-2 all-time versus St. Francis (Ill.), losing both decisions in last year's home-and-home conference series. Roosevelt fell at home to the Saints, 88-67, on Jan. 29 and then dropped a 78-57 decision to St. Francis (Ill.) on the road on Feb. 19. Senior Paul Tometich averaged 20.5 ppg in the two meetings last year and stuffed the stat sheet on Jan. 29 with 19 points, six rebounds and five assists.

LAST TIME OUT:

Neither senior Paul Tometich or Mark Tometich could connect on a game-winning shot in the final seconds as Roosevelt's valiant second-half rally came up just short in a 66-64 loss to Judson on Saturday night at Attack Athletics. The Lakers, who trailed the Eagles by 11 points with 10:47 left in the game, put the ball in the hands of its leading scorer, Paul Tometich, with the home side trailing by one in the waning moments, but his jumper rimmed out with three seconds left. Judson grabbed the rebound and was immediately fouled. Adam Hodge made the first free throw, but missed the second, giving the Lakers one final chance with two seconds remaining. Freshman Tino Vazquez sent a pass from the baseline to just beyond mid-court where freshman Joe Harks corralled it in traffic and dished it off to Mark Tometich, whose desperation three-pointer at the horn failed to connect. Mark Tometich finished the game with a team-high 17 points, knocking down four three-pointers. Paul Tometich totaled 12 points to go with seven assists and five rebounds. Sophomore Kyle Miklasz came off the bench to score 11 points, with a trio of triples coming in Roosevelt's second-half rally. Elliott Vaughn scored eight points and pulled down six rebounds.

TRENDING:

Freshman Elliott Vaughn has turned up his game of late for Roosevelt. The 6-foot-6 forward has tallied eight points in each of his last four outings while pulling down at least six rebounds in every contest during that span. Vaughn is now averaging 6.1 ppg this season and shooting a team-best 53 percent from the field. He now rates second on the team in rebounding at 4.6 rpg.

SCORING 70 IS KEY:

Head Coach Joe Griffin will be looking to get his offense to the 70-point mark in his upcoming outings as all six of the Lakers' wins this season have come when the squad has scored 70 or more points in a game. Since the reinstatement of athletics last season, Roosevelt has not won a game when scoring less than 70 points.

MINUTE MEN:

Roosevelt features 11 players this season averaging 12 or more minutes per game on the floor with no player seeing more than 27 minutes per contest.

BRANDYN HAS BEEN THE POST MAN:

Junior Brandyn Denson has given the Lakers a true post presence this season as the 6-foot-6 forward is averaging 9.4 points and 9.1 rebounds per game. Denson's 9.1 rpg rate second in the CCAC. Versus Marygrove on Dec. 17, he broke the single-game school record with 16 rebounds. Denson has three double-doubles this season, including a 15-point, 14-rebound effort versus Trinity Christian on Nov. 23, and has grabbed 10 or more rebounds in a game on six occasions. He pulled down a game-high 14 rebounds versus #25 Saint Xavier on Jan. 14.

NO AVERAGE JOE:

Freshman Joe Harks has worked his way into the Roosevelt starting lineup, with the 6-foot-3 guard from Glenbard South High School ranking fourth on the team in scoring at 6.8 ppg while shooting 52 percent from the field. Harks scored a career-high 21 points back on Nov. 23 versus Trinity Christian and pulled down a personal best six rebounds versus Peru State on Dec. 30.

FAB FIVE:

Five talented freshmen joined the Lakers in 2011-12. Elliott Vaughn, Joe Harks, Tyree York, Tino Vazquez and Odera Eneogwe each bring a decorated prep resume to the table. Vaughn nearly averaged a double-double at Batavia High School last season, posting 11.6 ppg and 9.2 rpg. Harks was an All-Area performer at Glenbard South High School. York was a standout for a Glenbard East side that placed third in the IHSA State Tournament last season. Vazquez averaged 9.6 ppg and 9.4 rebounds per game for prep power Proviso East. Eneogwe was an All-Area and All-State Special Mention recipient at Maine West High School.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH:

Head Coach Joe Griffin is the mastermind behind Roosevelt's men's basketball program. Griffin built the Lakers from scratch, and guided the squad to a 4-23 record in its inaugural season, including a signature win over then-nationally ranked St. Xavier. Griffin learned his trade under the tutelage of Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo, serving two seasons on the Spartans staff as a graduate assistant coach. With Michigan State, Griffin helped the Spartans to 50 wins and two NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 trip in 2008. Prior to his arrival at Roosevelt, Griffin spent one season as an assistant coach at NCAA Division II Eastern New Mexico.
