#### NEWS & NOTES:

##### FOR STARTERS:

Roosevelt enters the final week of the regular season in a three-way tie for fourth place in the CCAC with dates against two of the top three teams in the league still left on the slate. The Lakers take on third-place Robert Morris on Wednesday, Feb. 22, at 6:00 p.m. in their final regular season home game. Roosevelt then puts a cap on the regular season on Saturday at 1:00 p.m. with a trip to #10 Olivet Nazarene, which is a perfect 8-0 in league play this year. The Lakers are in a tie for fourth place in the conference with St. Francis (Ill.) and IUSB. Ending the year in fourth place would give Roosevelt a home game in the opening round of next week's CCAC Tournament.

##### SENIOR NIGHT:

Roosevelt will honor senior Alexia Tann, who will be playing in her final regular season home game, on Feb. 22 prior to the start of its tilt with city-rival Robert Morris. Tann transferred from Highland Community College in Freeport, Ill., to join the Lakers for their inaugural 2010-11

campaign. She made her presence felt right away, earning the starting nod at point guard and averaging 11.5 points and 3.5 assists through her first 13 games before her season was cut short with an ACL injury. Tann bounced backed to start every game thus far as a senior, averaging 8.0 points and a team-best 4.5 assists per game. In 41 career games, Tann is averaging 9.1 points and 4.2 assists per outing. She owns the Roosevelt single-game assist record, dishing out nine helpers on two occasions during her career. Tann also boasts the third-highest single-game scoring out-put with a 30-point performance at Grace College on Dec. 11, 2010.

### TRENDING:

Sophomore Casey Davis is finishing the regular season strong, averaging 19.7 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.3 assists in her last three games. She topped the 20-point plateau in two of her last three outings and in the one outing in which Davis didn't reach the mark she tied her career high with eight rebounds. Sophomore Kiara Towles has also been playing her best basketball of the season of late, totaling 14.5 points and 7.3 rebounds in her last four outings while shooting 58 percent from the field.

### SCOUTING ROBERT MORRIS:

Robert Morris will take on Roosevelt on Wednesday night in the familiar surroundings of Attack Athletics. Both the Lakers and Eagles play their home games at the facility with Robert Morris also utilizing the Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates, Ill. The Eagles are coming off a tough 78-73 loss to Olivet Nazarene on Saturday. Senior Sarah Rogers tallied 23 points and 21 rebounds in the setback. Rogers leads Robert Morris in both scoring (13.4 ppg) and rebounding (9.7 rpg) this season, while shooting 49 percent from the field. Uniqua Hampton chips in with 11.7 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. The Eagles wrap up the regular season on Saturday at Saint Xavier.

### ALL-TIME VERSUS THE EAGLES:

Roosevelt is 0-3 all-time versus its city rival Robert Morris, with the three contests decided by a total of 10 points. The Lakers dropped a 64-59 decision to the Eagles back on Feb. 1 at the Sears Centre. Roosevelt led by 10 points at the half, but a tenacious pressure defense installed by Robert Morris forced the Lakers into 40 turnovers and paved the way for an Eagles comeback. Sophomore Maria Tamburrino totaled 13 points and 12 rebounds for Roosevelt. Robert Morris' Sarah Rogers countered with 20 points and 15 boards.

### SCOUTING OLIVET NAZARENE:

Olivet Nazarene is one of the hottest teams in the country, having rattled off 15 straight victories. Most recently, the Tigers outlasted Robert Morris on Feb. 18, 78-73. Olivet Nazarene features the nation's highest scoring offense. The Tigers average 103 points per game and boast an average margin of victory of 21.7 points. Olivet Nazarene has knocked down a staggering 453 three-pointers this season, an average of 16.2 per contest. Danielle Tolbert leads the Tigers at 12.4 points per game, while teammate Denita Phelps totals 10.4 points and 7.8 rebounds per outing. The Tigers, who are 13-0 at home this season, host IU South Bend on Tuesday before welcoming the Lakers on Saturday.

### ALL-TIME VERSUS THE TIGERS:

Roosevelt is in search of its first-ever win versus Olivet Nazarene owning an 0-3 all-time record versus the Tigers. Roosevelt lost 111-82 at home to Olivet Nazarene on Feb. 4 despite double-doubles from Maria Tamburrino (17 points, 17 rebounds) and Kiara Towles (14 points, 13 rebounds). The Tigers have scored at least 107 points in every meeting with Roosevelt, which countered by scoring at least 80 points of its own in each contest.

### LAST TIME OUT:

Roosevelt picked up a much-needed CCAC victory on Friday night, leading from start to finish in a 77-65 triumph over St. Francis (Ill.) at Attack Athletics. Casey Davis scored 22 points to lead five Lakers sophomores in double figures. Kiara Towles and Maria Tamburrino each tabbed 14 points, Jennie Van Hook totaled 11 points and Tori Clark scored 10 points in a starting role. Senior Alexia Tann quarterbacked the Roosevelt offensive attack, tying her career high with nine assists. She also collected five steals. Van Hook led the Lakers on the boards with eight rebounds. Michelle Karr paced St. Francis (Ill.) with 28 points and 10 rebounds. Roosevelt kept one of the CCAC's top freshmen in check, limiting forward Katie Gonnering to just six points and three rebounds. Gonnering totaled 25 points and 10 board in the Fighting Saints' win over the Lakers earlier this season. Roosevelt jumped out to an 11-point lead in the opening five minutes. The Lakers led by eight at the half and then shot 52 percent in the final 20 minutes to earn the 75-55 victory.

### SCORING TITLE CHASE:

Sophomore Casey Davis is the hunt for the CCAC scoring title heading into the final week of the regular season. Roosevelt's top scorer is averaging 16.7 points per game, which is second-best in the league behind Saint Xavier's Marissa Young (16.8 ppg). St. Francis (Ill.) rookie Katie Gonnering is in third place at 16.5 ppg.

### GETTING TO THE LINE, CONVERTING AT THE LINE:

Sophomore Casey Davis' attacking style has led to her taking a team-high 152 free throw attempts this season. She has converted 82 percent of those charity tosses. Her 125 made free throws is more than any two of her teammates combined.

### RUNNING THE OFFENSE:

Senior Alexia Tann tied the Roosevelt single-game assist record versus St. Francis (Ill.) on Feb. 17 with nine helpers in a win over the Fighting Saints. The Beloit, Wis., native is averaging 7.5 assists per game in her last two outings and leads the teams, while ranking second in the CCAC, in assists at 4.5 apg.

### HIGH OCTANE OFFENSE:

Roosevelt enters the week owning the 11th-best scoring offense in the country, averaging 74.8 ppg. The Lakers boast an equal opportunity offense with six players averaging 8.0 points or more per game with sophomore Casey Davis leading the way at 16.7 ppg.

### EVERYDAY STARTER:

Sophomore Maria Tamburrino is the only player to have started every Roosevelt women's basketball game ever played with the streak hitting 58 on Feb. 17 versus St. Francis (Ill.).

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Sophomore Casey Davis was honored on Jan. 23 as the CCAC Division I Women's Basketball Player of Week. The 5-foot-8 guard led the Lakers, averaging 23.3 points per game while shattering the single-game scoring record in a victory over Trinity International on Jan. 16. Davis opened the week with a school record 33 points in an 87-77 win over the Trojans. Davis was 12-for-17 from the field and 8-for-9 from the foul line versus TIU while adding four rebounds and four assists. The County Club Hills, Ill., native backed up that performance with a 26-point effort to lead Roosevelt to a 78-63 road win over Holy Cross on Jan. 19. Davis then capped the week with 11 points, three rebounds and two assists in a setback at the hands of Judson on Jan. 21.
